

Creator+ is Here!

We previewed Creator+ in <u>previous issues</u> of this newsletter. Well, Creator+ is now available in D2L to help you create engaging and interactive course content as well as dynamic learning experiences. It offers three new features to enhance your HTML course content files.

Insert Element: Explore your creativity with <u>Creator+ Elements</u>, with a mix of static and dynamic elements that can be inserted into any course content file to

increase learner engagement. Use them to deliver noteworthy, visual, related, and/or sequenced information in an appealing and interactive way.



Insert Practice: Reinforce learning and provide valuable feedback with <u>Insert Practice</u> questions. Creator+ offers a range of practice exercises to allow learners to test their comprehension without the concern of impacting their course grade.

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Major Changes to Email in D2L

The Microsoft 365 Widget has debuted in D2L! This new tool integrates
Microsoft 365 directly into



the D2L environment, allowing both faculty and students to manage Lone Star College (Outlook) emails, calendar, and OneDrive files seamlessly from within D2L. This means you'll be able to access your Lone Star College email directly from D2L.

Please note that while both the Microsoft 365 and D2L email systems will be available for the remainder of this semester, **D2L email will** be retired after the Fall semester on December 18, 2024. Please be sure to forward any D2L emails that you wish

Respondus Monitor

By using LockDown Browser in conjunction with a webcam, Respondus Monitor allows students to take online assessments from a remote location - all while ensuring the integrity of the exam process. Here are some of the latest enhancements that Respondus has made to their product:

- Respondus Monitor now offers three sensitivity levels for flagging: Strict, Standard, and Relaxed. You can choose the right level after exams are done, with Strict being perfect for closed-book tests and Relaxed for open-book exams.
- They have <u>boosted flagging accuracy</u> by improving video resolution and enhancing computer vision models, cutting false positives by 80%. Plus, students are now prompted to adjust their camera tilt and lighting for better face detection and video quality, making reviews more efficient for instructors.
- Instructors now get proctoring <u>results in under 10 minutes</u> instead of waiting four hours, thanks to real-time analysis during exams. If technical issues pop up, the analysis happens after the exam to ensure consistent results.

Additionally, we recommend that you start using the Microsoft 365 widget during this transition period (Fall Semester) so you can familiarize yourself with its usage before D2L email is retired. The widget can be found on the D2L homepage, on the right below your list of courses, and at the top of the course homepage.

In addition to the widget, OneDrive has been added as an option for your students when submitting to Assignment Folders in D2L, allowing them to upload files straight from OneDrive without having to download them to their device first.
